**2) How to apply:** This is a walk-in selection process so the applicants may apply on or before 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 till 23:59 hrs. through the link given at the website <https://aecs4rbt.ac.in>. On the day of “**Skill Test & Demo Teaching**” applicants have to submit duly filled in application form along with latest passport size photograph & photocopies of testimonials/documents between 8.00 a.m. & 9.00 a.m. Candidates must apply separately for each post (if applying for more than one post). Applicants are requested to visit the website on regular basis for any further information.

The applicants must note that they will be allowed to appear for “Skill Test & Demo Teaching” only if they fulfill all the conditions of eligibility for the post applied for. Mere applying through link or submission of application form will not make the applicants eligible for “Skill Test & Demo Teaching” and empanelment for the posts of contract teachers. If any information furnished by a candidate is found to be wrong/misleading at any stage till the expiry of panels for the year, the candidature of such a candidate will be cancelled.

**a. Essential Qualifications:**

i) Master’s Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University’s/ institution’s norms) in the respective subject concerned.

OR

Integrated Post Graduate Course of Regional Institute of Education of NCERT or any other recognized institute in the respective subjects concerned with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/ institution's norms).

OR

Post Graduate degree in the respective subjects with at least 50% marks in aggregate or its equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/ institution's norms) from a recognized University and B.A.Ed./B.Sc.Ed. from a recognized institute.

ii) B.Ed. or equivalent degree from recognized University/Institute. B.Ed. is not required for the candidates with B.Sc. Ed. or B.A.Ed. or M.Sc. Ed.

iii) The candidates must have proficiency in Teaching in English Medium [Except PGT (Hindi)].

**b. Desirable – Working Knowledge of Hindi.**

**Note:**

1) In case of PGTs, the candidates without B.Ed., but having 60% and above marks in case of science subject(s) and 55% marks in case of humanities and commerce in Post Graduation may be considered.

2) **Candidates having B.Ed. in Special Education are not eligible to be considered for selection under above clause ii) category.**

**6. Educational and other Qualifications for Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT):**

**a. Essential Qualifications:**

i) Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (Obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms) in the respective subject(s) concerned/combination of subject(s) concerned.

OR

Four years integrated degree course-B.A.Ed. or B.Sc. Ed. from Regional College of Education of NCERT/from any National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (Obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms) in the respective subject(s) concerned/combination of subjects concerned.

**The candidate must possess the following Subject/Combination of subjects in their Graduation or equivalent Degree for the posts of TGTs as listed below:**

TGT (ART)	Bachelors of Fine Art (BFA)/ Bachelors of Visual Arts (BVA) in Painting/Drawing/Sculpture/Graphics OR equivalent degree of minimum four years duration from recognized University with at least 50% marks (in aggregate in Painting/Drawing/Sculpture/Graphics) by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms). OR Four years recognized Diploma in any discipline of Fine Art such as Drawing and Painting/Sculpture/Graphic Art (Applied/ Commercial) after passing Senior Secondary Examination (Class 12 <sup>th</sup> or equivalent) with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms). OR Five years recognized Diploma in any discipline of Fine Art such as Drawing and Painting/Sculpture/Graphic Art (Applied/ Commercial) after passing Secondary Examination (Class 10 <sup>th</sup> or equivalent) with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms).

TGT (PET- Male/ Female)	Three years Bachelor's degree in Physical Education with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (Obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms)

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#### 9. Mode of selection

i.	<b>Skill Test &amp; DEMO Teaching Class</b> – Every candidate must come with prior preparation of one Topic of subject as per his/her choice according to the level of post applied for. Two Topics will be given on the spot for DEMO Teaching for which the candidate will be asked to randomly draw two topics out of basket of topics through simultaneous two attempts.
ii.	Fifteen minutes time will be given to the candidates for preparation of topics for “SKILL TEST & DEMO Teaching” of the TOPICS allotted on the spot. The candidate will be appreciated to use appropriate Teaching Aids during “Skill Test and DEMO Teaching”. The maximum permissible time for “Skill Test and DEMO Teaching” will be 20 minutes.
iii	<p>Those who have been declared as “GO” in the “<b>Skill Test and DEMO Teaching</b>” will be empaneled in the order of merit based on the marks awarded by the committee for “SKILL Test and DEMO Teaching”. The selected candidates will be empanelled and the panel will be operated as and when vacancies arise in AEC Schools, Rawatbhata in the following manner:</p> <p><b>PREPARATION AND OPERATION OF PANEL: -</b></p> <p>(i) By maintaining the upper age limit of 65 years, three panels of contract teachers may be prepared in the following manner:</p> <p><b>(a) Panel I-</b> candidates in the order of merit with in this category of ‘with all the requisite qualifications for PGTs, TGTs, PRTs and Balvatika teachers’ and;</p> <p><b>(b) Panel II</b> - candidates in the order of merit with in this category of ‘without CTET for TGTs and PRTs’ separately and;</p>


	<p><b>(c) Panel III-</b> candidates in the order of merit with in this category of 'without teaching qualification for PGTs, TGTs, PRTs' separately.</p> <p>(ii) The panels mentioned above need to be operated in sequential order viz. Panel- I, II &amp; III respectively for the respective posts i.e. Panel- II and III for every post will be operated only after exhausting Panel-I &amp; II respectively.</p> <p>(iii) The validity of the panel will be only for one year i.e., from 1st April to 31st March.</p>
iv	Retired teachers from AEES/ KVS/NVS schools will have to appear for SKILL Test and DEMO Teaching for empanelment.

**10. General Information for all candidates:**

<b>i)</b>	<b>Candidates must bring the original certificates at the time of the Skill Test &amp; DEMO Teaching.</b>
ii)	Candidates are required to report at the venue strictly as per the time mentioned in the circular/advertisement.
iii)	Applications with insufficient details, copies of certificates etc. will be summarily rejected.
iv)	The candidates should note that their admission to the Skill Test & DEMO Teaching will be purely provisional, based on the information given by them in the online form. This will be subject to verification of all the eligibility conditions with reference to original documents as specified in the Recruitment notice. Candidature of an applicant is liable to be rejected at any stage of recruitment process or even after joining, if any information provided by the candidate during the entire process of recruitment/selection is found to be false or not in conformity with the eligibility criteria at any stage.
v)	They will be permitted to carry only the following items with them to the venue: a) Personal transparent water bottle (Candidate should bring his / her own water bottle) b) Any Self-made Teaching Aid. c) A blue ball point pen d) Documents – Originals & One set of Photocopies of Qualifications and Experiences, if any. e) No other items are permitted inside the venue. f) During preparation time for the SKILL Test & DEMO Class Teaching a candidate may be allowed to access Internet provided by the school or his/her personal Mobile/Laptop in a pre-defined area for the purpose. g) Candidates will not be allowed to share any of their personal belongings'/material/ information with anyone during the entire process of Skill test & Demo Teaching.
vi)	On completion of the SKILL Test & DEMO Teaching, the candidates should move out in an orderly manner without crowding as instructed by the venue staff.

viii)	No TA/DA will be paid for attending the Skill Test & DEMO Teaching.
