All India Secondary School Examination, 2022(Class X):

Out of 69 students who appeared in AISSCE- 2022, 53 secured first class i.e. above 60% marks. The class average is 74.2. The pass percentage is 100. The Excellence Index is 82.6 and the Quality Index is 7.3
