We also used Jaadui Pitara tool for children in this session.

Our Initiatives:

The Voice: The English Newspaper of AECS-2, Rawatbhata

The Newspaper is initiated to inculcate English Writing skills & to enhance the reading habits of our students. The stories are solely written by the member students of the Literary club of the school. So far we have released two editions of this newspaper.

Literary Club:

The Literary club is a paradise for thinkers, readers, and writers. It is the place where students are free to think, read and write on the topics of their interest and choice. The club is also a forum where students share their insights on politics, school activities etc. at present there are 82 participants in the this club. It is still going on smoothly. Children are sent a word of the day everyday for their vocabulary building to enhance their knowledge about English Language.

Quiz Club:

Quizzing is an art and a test of the intellect. The quiz club of the school aim at identifying students with quizzing talent and creating opportunities for them to sharpen their quizzing skills. There are 149 participants in this club and now it is going on by sending the material of G.K. Current affairs, politics etc in the group on regular basis.

Monthly MCQ Test:

In order to make the students ready for the competitive exams, our students appear in MCQ tests in all the major subjects every month. These tests are conducted for classes III to X. The results are declared within a week and shared with the parents.

School Assemblies:

School Assemblies provide ample opportunities for all our students to come forth with self-courage and express their abilities of public speaking, reading, thought sharing etc.

A morning assembly in the school is one of the most vital features of a school's set of courses. It is one of the sessions in any school where all the members of the school, the students and the teachers come together for prayer and make the entire day a good one. It is also a platform where the students can express their thoughts, feelings and display their talent. We conduct a number of activities in our school's morning assembly for the same.

A thought for the day, pledge, news headlines and birthday celebrations are conducted on daily basis whereas poetry recitation, book review, storytelling based on moral values, G.K. Quiz, role plays etc. are conducted on the rotation basis. All the important days and celebrations are also observed in the school during the Morning Assembly in order to acquaint our students with the rich cultural aspects, traditions and history of our great nation. The Yoga & Mass PT is also being practiced on day-to-day basis.

Co-curricular Activities and Celebrations:
